TASK FOR THE GROUP

1. After reading the above introduction assigned to your pair/group please have a discussion with your pair/team and develop your short real or imaginary scenarios, based on your personal experience, knowledge and opinions.

You have to describe your scenario and explain the reasons behind the conflict and its consequences. The following questions are given to facilitate your:

- What is going on?
- Who is involved in this conflict and who is affected?
- What are the reasons behind this conflict?
- What are the consequences?
- 2. You have 15-20 minutes to prepare.
- 3. Then you will be asked to present your thoughts/answers on your task. Each pair/group will have 5 minutes to present and you should decide to have 1 spokesperson per group.
- 4. After each presentation the other pairs/groups will be asked to share their thoughts and solution proposals on each scenario. Group discussion.
